Submission of Extended abstracts

Authors who wish to publish their research at ISymRU 2021 must submit the extended abstracts according to the following guidelines.

General Guidelines

- Authors can submit their work for either oral or poster presentations. Oral presentations will be held in parallel sessions under the tracks of the Conference. Poster presentations will be displayed throughout the conference.
- Authors should upload blind extended abstracts (leaving out the names of authors and their affiliations for blind reviewing) in the initial submission to the EasyChair system. Details of all authors must be added to the authors section of the EasyChair submission page. Single authorships are not entertained, and all undergraduate and postgraduate students must get the consent from supervisors for the author list.
- Extended abstracts submitted with author details (in the abstract) will not be considered for reviewing and authors will be requested to resubmit according to the given instructions.
- Authors should add names and affiliations to the abstract only after the abstract has been revised according to the comments of the reviewers and is ready for final submission.
- Research work presented or published elsewhere will not be considered for publication.
- Authors should submit extended abstracts under the given tracks. The Editorial Board reserves the right to change the track of the abstract to a relevant track, if deemed necessary.
- Author Declaration Form signed by all authors and any supervisor consent forms should be sent to editor.isymru@rjt.ac.lk.

Specific guidelines for preparing extended abstracts

- Margins and spacing:- Extended abstracts must be double spaced, with margins of 1.5 inches (left) and 1 inch (top, right and bottom).
- Font and font size: Times New Roman with 12 font size .
- Length:- Maximum 1500 words and minimum 1000 words
- File format:- Extended abstracts must be submitted in a word file format
- Title:- Written in uppercase, font size 14, bold and centred
- Authors:- Name, affiliation, address, email of all the authors, font size 10

- Key words:- maximum of 5 keywords.

Subheadings of the extended abstract:

1. Abstract : Should be written as a single paragraph and justified. Should not have any sub-headings, figures or tables. References should not be included in the abstract nor listed at the end. Limited to 300 words.
2. Introduction: Should also include clear objectives and is limited to 300 words.
3. Methodology: Limited to 300 words.
4. Results and Discussion: Limited to 500 words.
5. Conclusions: Limited to 100 words.
6. References :Limit to 5 key references and follow the Vancouver style
7. Figures and Tables: Should be very clear. Limited to two each for the entire extended abstract.

Submission of the camera-ready copy

Once the paper is accepted, submit the camera-ready copy (only the abstract maximum of 500 words) after addressing the comments of the reviewers. The method of submission would be notified to you in due course.

Registration for authors

At least the presenting author must register for the conference once the paper is accepted. Only registered participants are eligible for the full program docket.
