#### An Apiary was Established at the Rajarata University Mihintale Premises

The Rajarata University of Sri Lanka has been working on beekeeping for the last decade involving teaching, research projects and extension programs to develop the sector and popularize technologies. An apiary was established at the Rajarata University Mihintale premises on 26th August 2022 to provide the technologies for a wider community with the guidance of Prof. (Mrs.) G.A.S. Ginigaddara, the Vice Chancellor of the university. Bee hives developed for easy observation of the colonies and behaviour of the bees inside the colony were donated by Mr. Jagath Randeniya who lives in Germany. Beekeeping practices were demonstrated by Dr. Anura Sirisena from the Faculty of Agriculture. The Registrar, Librarian, Deans, Heads of the Departments, Executive staff, Non-academic staff and students also participated in this important event of the university. As per the expectation of the present Vice Chancellor of the university, the apiary will be expanded further in the near future in order to conserve bees while popularizing beekeeping as an enterprise among the student community.

Two Professors from the Faculty of Medicine and Allied Sciences, Rajarata University of Sri Lanka, Prof. Suneth Agampodi and Prof. Channa Jayasumana were ranked among the world's top 2% scientists for the second consecutive time, in the Science-wide author databases of standardized citation indicators published on 10th October 2022 by Elsevier BV and Stanford University. The selection was based on the top 100,000 scientists by c-score or a percentile rank of 2% or higher in the 176 subfields. Calculations were performed using all Scopus author profiles as of 1st September 2022.








#### Awareness Session on Preparation of Course Specifications












#### Publication of a Handbook



#### DoCM PG Trainees Claim Two out of Five Awards in the CCPSL Session.










#### Art Competition to Commemorate the World Ozone Day






**OWSD Early Career Fellowship 2022**




#### The Department of Food Technology Received an STHRD Project Grant

The Science and Technology Human Resource Development (STHRD) project performed under the Ministry of Education is aimed at supporting the government in developing Applied Sciences and Technology Faculties in several national universities in Sri Lanka with the financial assistance of the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Under the STHRD project, several competitive research grant (CRG) schemes have been awarded. The Department of Food Technology, Rajarata University of Sri Lanka, also received a grant of LKR 5,270,000/- and USD 8,100/- for their recent project proposal. The project will be performed with the leadership of Dr. R. K. Ahinsa as the Principle investigator and with the partnership of the University of Peradeniya, Sri Lanka.

## Signing a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Bioprocess Technology, Faculty of Technology and BIOGREEN Technologies

This initiative will bring together the university and industry professionals, allowing them to develop solutions that will benefit both parties. The Department of Food Technology undergraduates gains vast academic knowledge and experience related to food chemistry, food microbiology, product development technology and sensory evaluations, food physics and food engineering, quality assurance, safety and regulations and food preservation and vice versa. Despite gaining theoretical knowledge through advanced lecture series, the students get practical experiences through laboratory classes, field visits, industrial training and final-year research projects.

Every year, undergraduates in their third academic year pursue a 24-week industrial training to fulfil the degree's requirements. The undergraduates in the 2017/2018 batch of the Department of Food Technology started their industrial training with effect from October 2022. In addition to advanced training in the industry, the undergraduates gain vast experience in applying their subject knowledge in planning and implementing various research projects and scientifically implementing the research outcomes through their undergraduate research project. The undergraduates in the 2016/2017 batch of the Department of Food Technology completed their undergraduate research projects by the end of December 2022 and will present their research findings within the first week of January 2023.







#### The Department of Food Technology Purchased Several Advanced Laboratory Equipment

The Department of Food Technology is furnished with sophisticated equipment for various purposes such as food processing and analysis, including Freeze Dryer, Fat Extractor, Crude Fiber Extractor, UV Visible Spectrophotometer, Texture Profile Analyzer, and Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometer (GC-MS). Furthermore, the Department of Food Technology also purchased Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer (AAS), Biosafety Cabinet and a Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD) apparatus.
